1. To work with and provide assistance to the church staff as requested on a day-to-day basis and to serve as a liaison with the CLC (Church Leadership Council) and Deacons.

6. To do whatever else is requested of it by the CLC, Deacons, staff and church family to insure a smooth period of transition.
