PERCUSSION

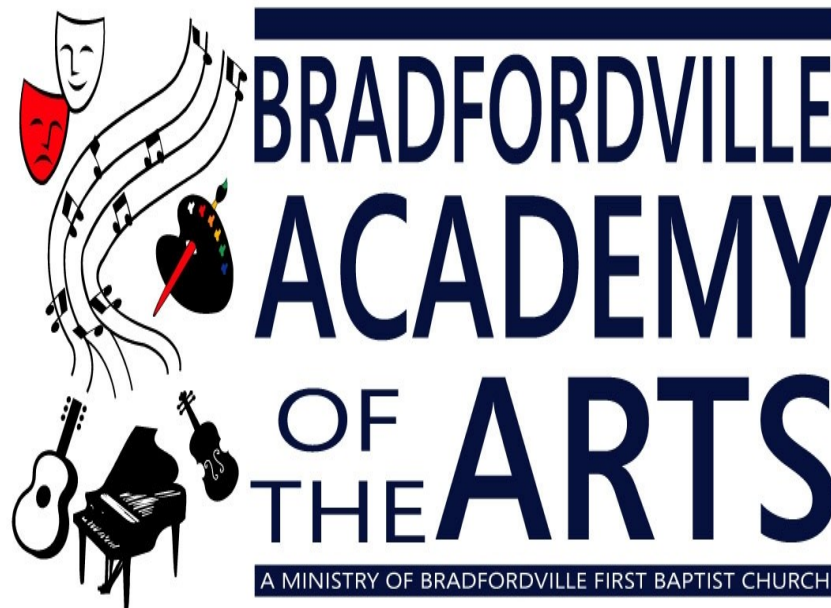

Instruction: Music lessons are single-student one half hour in length. Art and Drama are taught in a group setting. The length of these classes depends on the instructor.

Schedules: Lesson and class schedules depend on instructor availability. Every effort will be made to coordinate the lesson schedules to be convenient for instructors and students.

Cancellation Policy: Contact the instructor within 24 hours of the lesson if at all possible. Illness and unexpected emergencies will be dealt with on a case by case basis. Makeup lessons will be coordinated with individual instructors. If a student withdraws from classes, notice must be given to the Academy Administrator or instructor one month prior to withdrawal. The time slot may be reassigned.
